Membership Criteria

Your corporation will have one primary and up to three associate members

The primary member applicant and the club will participate in a screening process to make sure that there is a good fit for both organizations.

Associate members will be selected by the primary member, when approved for membership.

Your corporation will be able to replace a member as required.

Should a primary or associate member leave the corporation, they may request to join the Club as an individual member.

The annual corporate fee is \$500 plus annual meal costs for one person.
